

We are very excited to be opening our “ Marquee Doors” on the 12th of April, we have missed you all dearly and we cannot wait to welcome you back. To do this in a safe way we have created a simple guidelines list with some of the rules & precautions we are taking to keep everyone safe.

If you have Covid symptoms we kindly ask you not to visit us for everyone’s safety and please follow the NHS guidance

The rule of 6 applies, meaning we can have a maximum of 6 guests from 6 different households

We can allow more than 6 guests on the same table providing they are from a maximum of 2 households plus 1 support bubble (a support bubble can be a single person or a couple with a baby under 1)

We will have a Meet & Greet station where we will welcome you. We will need to collect the details necessary and show you to your table, please don’t enter the Marquee without checking-in

Your personal details are vital to comply with Track & Trace, we will have a QR-Code ready on your arrival where you can check in with your NHS Covid App, this is for everyone aged 16 years or over. If you haven’t got the APP we will require all of our guest’s names, addresses & telephone numbers.

Sanitising stations will be available on arrival and throughout your visit

All guests must wear a face covering when entering the pub to use the toilets or pay

All of our staff will wear masks indoors & outdoors

Our tables outdoors are distanced at 2 metres or 1m with mitigation, such as a one-way system, we can also confirm that more than 50% of the sides of our Marquee will be open so it will ensure ventilation

We understand everyone is very excited about going out again, we must remind our guests that shouting, singing & chanting isn’t aloud

We cannot allow live music but we will have background music at all times

We kindly ask our guests with children to ensure they are supervised at all times

Your table & seats will be cleaned used a Coronavirus killing spray after each use

Your condiments will be cleaned after each table is use

We will be using single use menus

Guests will not be allowed to go to the bar, we operate on a table service only basis

Guests will no longer need to order food in order to purchase a drink

We no longer have a 10pm curfew, we will now operate our times according to our licence

We don’t have a waiting area as such so if you have made a booking we would kindly ask you to be here around 5 minutes before your reservation

We really miss our guests but sadly under current conditions we will not be able to greet you with a hand shake or a kiss!

We will try to reduce the amount of staff coming to your table by splitting the Marquee into “Sections”

We encourage our guests to use contactless payments

Our table plan has been setup in a way to ensure everyone’s safety, please refrain from moving tables or joining tables together without checking with us

We will have 1 allocated Manager to monitor our guests to ensure the guidelines are being met

Please note these are just some of many precautions we are taking to keep you and our staff safe.
