White Wines

Solandia Grillo, Sicily, Italy	22.95
The Grillo grape is native to Sicily and produces a very rounded style with a luscious palate of ripe fruit and soft acidity. Straw-yellow in colour with youthful green highlights. The bouquet shows ripe yellow peach and mango with notes of almond and camomile.	
Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine Jean-Claude Chatelain, France	32.95
Sauvignon Blanc in full glory with a flinty aroma opening into a determined gooseberry crunchiness. Arguably the finest dry, white from the Loire region.	
Strofilia White Dot Moschofilero-Roditis Dry White, Peloponnese, Greece	25.95
Rose petals, lemon blossom and citrus: fresh and aromatic.	
Loosen Brothers, Dr L Riesling, Mosel, Germany	25.95
The Riesling grapes used to make Dr L come exclusively from traditional vineyards with steep slopes and slate soils. Fresh and with the classic Mosel raciness, it shows citrus fruits such as grapefruit and lime with mineral notes and a touch of spritz on the finish.	
Quinta das Arcas Arca Nova Branco, Vinho Verde, Portugal	22.95
Green apple and sweet pear with a touch of spritz on the finish.	
Kleine Zalze Cellar Selection Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Coastal Region, S. Africa	22.95
Soft and creamy, a hint of ripe exotic fruit and a delicious vanilla sweetness.	
Lolo Albariño Rías Baixas, Spain	25.95
Notes of zippy, green apple and lemon peel with a hint of white-fleshed plum.	
Gavi Ca' - Italy	26.95
White flowers and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and refreshing minerality	
Picpoul de pinet, Reserve de Mirou – France	23.95
Fuller bodied Muscadet with plenty of citrusy fruit	
Petit Chablis, Vignerons de Chablis, France	28.95
Citrus and floral notes, fresh and lively on the palate.	

Red Wines

Alma Mora Malbec, San Juan, Argentina 25.95

full-bodied with ripe red berry and plum flavours finishing with a long, elegant touch of toasty vanilla.

Red Knot Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia 28.95

Ripe strawberry and blackberry are embellished with floral, milk chocolate and black pepper nuances.

Casa Vista Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile 22.95

Ripe plum and damson fruit aromas, plenty of fruit, smooth, gently spiced finish.

Côtes du Rhône Auguste Bessac, France 23.95

The warmth and sunshine of the Rhône Valley encourages the ripe berry style with pepper hints. Easy-drinking and medium-bodied.

Château La Fleur Plaisance, Montagne-Saint-Émilion, France 32.95

Traditional Claret, harvested entirely by hand, and made to give a full-bodied, soft Merlot-based wine with a complex ripe bouquet.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Cornalines, France 41.95

Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.

Kleine Zalze Cellar Selection Fairtrade, Pinotage, South Africa 29.95

Shows mulberry and black plum fruit flavours on a soft and spicy palate.

Solandia Nero D'Avola Italy

This is a grape variety native to Sicily. With its dark, ripe-berried fruit and a hint of liquorice and vanilla spice, it shows a similarity in style to Shiraz. 22.95

Vina Pomal Centenario Rioja Crianza, Spain 25.95

Deep morello-cherry red with violet hues; black fruit, liquorice and subtle mineral notes, cocoa and toasty notes from barrel ageing; supple and balanced with a refreshing finish.

Drifting, Old Vine Zinfandel, USA 29.95

Sweet cherry, blueberry and light plum aromas and flavours lift your senses and are completed with a black pepper spice and slight tobacco that end in a full and silky finish.

Bella Amarone, Della Valpolicella Classico Italy 49.95

Drying the grapes first ensures an enveloping, velvet richness with marzipan, raisin and date flavours

Fleurie France

Lively & intense red colour with aromas of red berries 28.95

Sparkling, Rose & Champagne

Prosecco Santa Fosca Italy (VG)

Glass 4.95 25.95

Straw yellow in colour with light-green hues; delicate fruit bouquet, reminiscent of wild apples and acacia flowers; dry, with subtle fruit and nut flavours.

Galanti Prosecco Rosé Extra Dry Italy (VG)

Glass 4.95 25.95

Made with 87% Glera and 13% Pinot Noir from the Veneto & Friuli regions of North Eastern Italy. This vibrant pale pink Prosecco is freshening with light summer fruits with a hint of white peach.

Louis Dornier et Fils Brut, France

39.95

A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate.

Montaudon Réserve Première Brut, France

45.00

Shows floral aromas, followed by notes of apple and pear: the palate is fresh and fruit driven.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV,

65.00

Well known for both its full-bodied, biscuity style and its consistency. A black grape dominated blend, using 50% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier together with 30% Chardonnay. A blend of over 50 crus, mostly Premier and Grand Cru, with over 25% reserve wines.

Taittinger Brut Réserve

60.00

Light, delicate and elegant; dry, fresh and balanced with a green fruit and citrus character. Produced from first pressings, with up to 20% of reserve wine used to ensure consistency of style from year to year. The blend is 40% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 25% Pinot Meunier; it receives three to four years ageing prior to release, this results in subtle hints of biscuit and brioche.

Laurent-Perrier Rosé Champagne

90.00

This is a classic pink fizz made with a method rarely applied in Champagne. The result's plenty of stylish strawberry fruit, vivacity and easy-drinking charm. It's a wonderfully refreshing apéritif. But its elegant structure means that it also works well with a variety of dishes, particularly shellfish.
